

1. Membership Terms

Art 1.00: All paragraphs, among all existing chapters on this website, preceded by the term 'Art' are part of the Rules of Internal Order (RIO). When accepting the membership you agree to the terms of the RIO.

Art 1.01. The duration of the membership is one full calendar year, or from the time of completion of the registration, if the year has already started until the end of the calendar year (31 December 20xx)

Art 1.02. The membership is accepted when the contribution is paid for the membership. This contribution is fixed at €25

Art 1.03. The membership is accepted if the member has reached the age of 5 years at the time of application for membership.

Art 1.04. To submit an application for membership you must fill in the registration form completely and correctly. You must provide a copy of your ID card (front and back) to info@bocra.be. At the end of filling in the registration procedure you will be automatically transferred to the payment of the membership fee.

Art: 1.05. Once your membership is complete you will receive a confirmation as of then you are insured. Keep in mind this could take a couple of days.

Art 1.06. BOCRA is permitted to refuse a membership. Upon completion of payment the membership fee will be paid back fully.

Art 1.07. BOCRA is permitted to exclude a member for failure to comply with the membership conditions / RIO.

Art 1.08. Exclusion due to compelling reasons (i.e. non-compliance of the membership conditions) the membership fee will not be refunded.

Art 1.09. It is strictly forbidden to engage in direct or indirect commercial activities in the broadest sense of the word, if they relate to BOCRA, unless prior written permission is received from the Board.

Art 1.10. Each member gives BOCRA the authorization for the use of images for commercial purposes and promotion. If a member does not wish this they should explicitly inform the Board in writing. (E-mail, letter ...)

Art 1.11. When participating in events that work together with BOCRA the organization of this event has the final responsibility. This could involve a competition, training and all other sorts of events.

Art 1.12. The member may terminate his membership at any time, the membership fees will not be refunded.

Art 1.13. If the membership is not renewed and the membership fee is not paid by 31 December, the membership will be automatically terminated on 01 January.

Art 1.14. One can start the membership procedure from the 15th of October in the year proceeding to the calendar year in which the membership applies.

Art 1.15. Each Member shall respect the norms and values of BOCRA, both in your home country as abroad. If the Board receives complaints about a member who does not

respect these values, the Board may proceed to the removal of the member from BOCRA.

Art 1.16. With every change of the RIO, the member will be notified by e-mail. The member is permitted to appeal against these changes. For this, the member has 72 hours to inform the Board via email of his comments. If no agreement is found regarding the implementation of the modified RIO the membership for this member will be removed, and he gets refunded his x / 12 membership fee. If there are no launched appeals after 72uur, the new RIO is considered as binding.

Art 1.17. For disputes with BOCRA the Belgian courts have jurisdiction and the Belgian law is applicable. The courts of East Flanders are territorial competent.
